Position Summary:

Summer Camp Program Faculty will teach 3-credit introductory courses for the Burlington College high school summer camps. Faculty are expected to be subject-matter experts in the specific areas of focus. Areas of focus and dates are (all dates are 9 am to 5 pm):

- Graphic Design/Photography - July 9-20, July 23-August 3, and August 6-17
- Film – July 23-August 3
- Craft and Woodworking – August 6-17

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

- In coordination with the Summer Program Director, assist with developing program plans and camp goals
- Facilitate the learning experiences of students enrolled in the summer camp program
- Lead classes that are active and promote student-guided exploratory learning
- Work collaboratively with Camp Counselors to ensure campers' safety and well-being
- Monitor student progress
- Provide care and protection of College property

- Current First Aid and CPR Certifications required
- BA Degree required
- Experience working with high school aged children
- Enthusiastic, positive, energetic and strong sense of humor
- Ability to maintain appropriate boundaries with co-workers and camp participants
