Position Title: Overnight Camp Counselor
Department: Summer Camps

Position Detail: Full Time, Seasonal

Position Summary:

Overnight Camp Counselors will enthusiastically lead the high school summer camps. Counselors should be experienced enough in the focus area of the camp to support faculty and contribute to the educational experience of camp participants. Areas of focus and dates are:

- Graphic Design/Photography - July 9-20, July 23-August 3, and August 6-17
- Film – July 23-August 3
- Craft – August 6-17

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

- Counselors will live on the Burlington College campus for the duration of the camp
- Guide campers in participating successfully in camp activities
- Assist in planning and actively participate in camp activities
- Responsible for camper safety and fun during the non-academic portion of the camp
- Recognize and respond appropriately to opportunities for group problem solving
- Encourage respect for personal and College property, equipment and facilities
- Set a good example for campers, including cleanliness, punctuality, respect, rules and demeanor
- Other duties as assigned

Qualifications and Requirements:

- Current Lifeguard, First Aid and CPR Certifications required
- Experience working with high school aged children
- Enthusiastic, positive, energetic and strong sense of humor
- Ability to maintain appropriate boundaries with co-workers and camp participants
- Demonstrated ability to work effectively in a cooperative, team-oriented atmosphere
