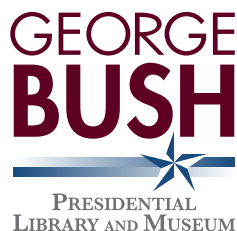
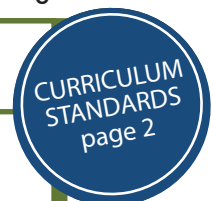
FIRST LADY BARBARA BUSH
