Dr. Cynthia Rand is a Professor of Medicine in the Pulmonary and Critical Care Medicine Department and Associate Dean for Faculty at the Johns Hopkins School of Medicine. Her long-standing research interests include healthcare disparities, outcomes and quality of life, asthma, and COPD therapy adherence. With her interests in the social-behavioral meditates of asthma management in minority communities, Dr. Rand has been the principle investigator of multiple pediatric intervention trials focusing on improving adherence and reducing childhood asthma morbidity as well as racial and ethnic health disparities.
