Chrome

Export Bookmarks

1. From the “Hot Dog Menu” at the upper right choose Bookmarks > Bookmark manager > Organize (although it doesn’t look like a button go ahead and click on it) > Export bookmarks to HTML file
2. Save the file to disk, then upload to your gDrive.

Import Bookmarks

1. Download the file from your gDrive to the computer, then do step 2.
2. From the “Hot Dog Menu” at the upper right choose Bookmarks > Bookmark manager > Organize (although it doesn’t look like a button go ahead and click on it) > Import bookmarks from HTML file
3. Choose the downloaded file.



Firefox

Export Bookmarks

1. On the menu bar, click Bookmarks and select Show All Bookmarks.
2. Find the menu with the Star at the top. Pull it down and choose “Export Bookmarks to HTML...”
3. Save the bookmarks file. Uploading it to your gDrive is probably best.

Import Bookmarks

1. On the menu bar, click Bookmarks and select Show All Bookmarks.
2. Find the menu with the Star at the top. Pull it down and choose “Import Bookmarks to HTML”...
3. Choose the bookmarks file from wherever you stored it.



Safari

Export Bookmarks

1. Choose File > Export Bookmarks.
2. Specify a location for the exported file. The file's name is "Safari bookmarks.html." Most browsers are able to import this type of file.

Import Bookmarks

1. Choose File > Import Bookmarks.
2. Browse to find the file that contains the bookmarks you want to import (the one that you made above), and then click Import. Normally the file has ".html" or ".plist" at the end of its name.
