




## NEUMEYER KEYNOTE SPEAKER

George Berdejo, BA, RVT, FSVU

Mr. Berdejo is the director of vascular ultrasound outpatient services at the White Plains Hospital in White Plains, New York. Previous to that, George was director of vascular ultrasound services at Montefiore Medical Center in New York City from October 1989 through December 2011.

His leadership and experience include serving as an item writer for the American Registry for Diagnostic Medical Sonography (ARDMS) as well as being on the annual conference planning committees of both the Society of Diagnostic Medical Sonography (SDMS) and the American Institute of Ultrasound in Medicine (AIUM). He is a former board member and past 2004–2005 president of the Society for Vascular Ultrasound (SVU) and is currently on their annual conference committee. In addition, he has served on the Journal for Vascular Ultrasound (JVU) editorial review board as well as contributing section editor of JVU's Doppler Digest. Since 1992, George has been the chair for the Advances in Vascular Imaging and Diagnosis (AVID) Symposium, which is considered to be among the best vascular ultrasound meetings of its kind in the world.

Mr. Berdejo has published more than 40 manuscripts, abstracts and book chapters, primarily addressing the diagnosis and treatment of various vascular disease processes. George's career has been highlighted by a passion for the advancement of quality vascular ultrasound through education of practicing technologists and sonographer as well as mentoring and training of ultrasound students, medical and surgical residents and young faculty. George has also passionately advocated on behalf of the mission of the SVU and its members through his meeting. He has dedicated his career to serving as a role model for his students, is a respected colleague across health professions and has been a strong community leader and a national voice in vascular ultrasound.




