We are a therapeutic day-camp that runs from 9:00-3:00 4 days a week for 8 weeks throughout the summer. We offer activity-themed groups (such as a mountain biking, canoeing, art, science and many more). We serve children with social, emotional and behavioral challenges. Each group will be supported by trained staff with knowledge of each client's needs. Interns will be responsible for coordinating activities and running groups.

For each week of camp you will get at least 24 hours of direct experience facilitating a camp group. Groups consist of about 5 clients. You will also receive about 10 hours of training as well as professional feedback and experience.

Academic credit is possible. Specifics must be worked out in writing before any internship can begin.
